IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that unless **CONSTANCE RUTH GABRIEL** License Number **1009268** disassociates from License Number **950078**, on or before the effective date of this decision, the same penalties imposed upon License Number **1009268** shall be imposed upon License Number **950078**, pursuant to and in accordance with Sections 7097 and 7098 of the Contractors License Law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that unless **CONSTANCE RUTH GABRIEL** License Number **1009268** disassociates from License Number **1004259**, on or before the effective date of this decision, the same penalties imposed upon License Number **1009268** shall be imposed upon License Number **1004259**, pursuant to and in accordance with Sections 7097 and 7098 of the Contractors License Law.

Pursuant to Government Code section 11520, subdivision (c), Respondent may serve a written motion requesting that the Decision be vacated and stating the grounds relied on within seven (7) days after service of the Decision on Respondent. The agency in its discretion may vacate the Decision and grant a hearing on a showing of good cause, as defined in the statute.

This Decision shall become effective on May 16, 2018.

14	Registrar of Contractors (Registrar) for the Contractors' State License Board (Board).		
15	(Accusation attached as Exhibit A.)		
16	2. On or about November 30, 2015, the Registrar issued Contractor's License No.		
17	1009268, B to Respondent. The Contractor's License expired on November 30, 2017, and has not		
18	been renewed. This lapse in licensure, however, pursuant to Business and Professions Code		
19	section 7106.5 does not deprive the Board of its authority to institute or continue this disciplinary		
20	proceeding.		
21	3. On or about February 2, 2018, Respondent was served by Certified and First Class		
22	Mail copies of the Accusation No. N2017-304, Statement to Respondent, Notice of Defense,		
23	Request for Discovery, and Discovery Statutes (Government Code sections 11507.5, 11507.6,		
24	and 11507.7) at Respondent's address of record which, pursuant to Business and Professions		
25	Code section 136, is required to be reported and maintained with the Board. Respondent's		
26	address of record was and is:

28	San Jose, CA 95125.		
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1	4. Service of the Accusation was effective as a matter of law under the provisions of		
2	Government Code section 11505, subdivision (c) and/or Business & Professions Code section		
3	124.		
4	5. Government Code section 11506(c) states, in pertinent part:		
5	(c) The respondent shall be entitled to a hearing on the merits if the respondent		
6 7	files a notice of defense and the notice shall be deemed a specific denial of all parts of the accusation not expressly admitted. Failure to file a notice of defense shall constitute a waiver of respondent's right to a hearing, but the agency in its discretion may nevertheless grant a hearing.		
8	<ul> <li>6. The Registrar takes official notice of the Board's records and the fact that Respondent</li> </ul>		
9	failed to file a Notice of Defense within 15 days after service upon it of the Accusation, and

12	(a) If the respondent either fails to file a notice of defense or to appear at the hearing, the agency may take action based upon the respondent's express admissions or upon other evidence and affidavits may be used as evidence without any notice to respondent		
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15	8. Pursuant to its authority under Government Code section 11520, the Registrar finds		
16	Respondent is in default. The Registrar will take action without further hearing and, based on the		
17	relevant evidence contained in the Default Decision Investigatory Evidence Packet in this matter,		
18	as well as taking official notice of all the investigatory reports, exhibits and statements contained		
19	therein on file at the Board's offices regarding the allegations contained in Accusation No.		
20	N2017-304, finds that the charges and allegations in Accusation No. N2017-304, are separately		
21	and severally, found to be true and correct by clear and convincing evidence.		
22	9. The Registrar finds that the actual costs for investigation and prosecution are		
23	\$2,294.62 as of February 26, 2018.		
24	10. The Registrar finds that the loss to B.Q. caused by the acts or omissions of		
25	Respondent is \$59,825.00.		
26	DETERMINATION OF ISSUES		
27	1. Based on the foregoing findings of fact, Respondent has subjected its Contractor's		
28	License No. 1009268, B to discipline.

2	3.	The Registrar of Contractors is authorized to revoke Respondent's contractor's license	
3	based upo	n the following violations alleged in the Accusation which are supported by the

4	omission constituting a cause for disciplinary action constitutes a cause for disciplinary action		
5	against a licensee who at the time that the act or omission occurred was the qualifying individual		
6	of that individual, partnership, corporation, limited liability company, firm, or association,		
7	whether or not he or she had knowledge of or participated in the prohibited act or omission.		
8	Therefore, pursuant to section 7122.5, Constance Ruth Gabriel, is subject to discipline regardless		
9	of whether or not she had knowledge of or participated in the act(s) or omissions(s) in Accusation		
10	No. N2017-304.

On or about November 30, 2015, the Registrar of Contractors issued Contractor's 6 License Number 1009268, B to Sunrooms America, Inc., Constance Ruth Gabriel, 7 RMO/CEO/Pres (Respondent). The Contractor's License expired on November 30, 2017, and has 8 not been renewed. 9 On or about July 19, 2010, the Registrar of Contractors issued Contractor's License 3. 10 Number 950078, B to Bay Area Fun Space Direct, Inc, dba Sunrooms America Direct, Constance 11 Ruth Gabriel, RMO/CEO/Pres (Affiliated Party #1). The Contractor's License expired on April 12 30, 2015, and has not been renewed. 13 On or about June 5, 2015, the Registrar of Contractors issued Contractor's License 4. 14 Number 1004259, B to Gabriel Construction Company, Constance Ruth Gabriel, sole owner 15 (Affiliated Party #2), The Contractor's License will expire on June 30, 2019, unless renewed. 16 17 **JURISDICTION** This Accusation is brought before the Registrar of Contractors (Registrar) for the 5. 18 Contractors' State License Board, Department of Consumer Affairs, under the authority of the 19 following laws. All section references are to the Business and Professions Code unless otherwise 20indicated. 2122 STATUTORY PROVISIONS Section 7090 of the Business and Professions Code ("Code") provides, in pertinent 23б. part, that the Registrar may suspend or revoke any license or registration if the licensee or  $\mathbf{24}$ registrant is guilty of or commits any one or more of the acts or omissions constituting cause for 25 disciplinary action. 26 Section 7106.5 of the Code provides, in pertinent part, that the expiration, 7. 27 cancellation, forfeiture, or suspension of a license by operation of law or by order or decision of 28

the registrar, or a court of law, or the voluntary surrender of the license shall not deprive the
 registrar of jurisdiction to proceed with any investigation of or action or disciplinary proceeding
 against the license, or to render a decision suspending or revoking the license.

8. Section 118(b) of the Code provides, in pertinent part, that the expiration of a license shall not deprive the Registrar of jurisdiction to proceed with a disciplinary action during the period within which the license may be renewed, restored, reissued or reinstated. Under Code section 7076.1, the Registrar may reinstate a cancelled license if the licensee pays all of the fees and meets all of the qualifications and requirements for obtaining an original license.

9 9. Section 7076.5 of the Code provides, in pertinent part, that the inactive status of a
10 license shall not bar any disciplinary action for violating provisions of the Contractors' State
11 License Law (Bus. & Prof. Code, § 7000, et seq.).

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10. Section 7109 of the Code states:

"(a) A willful departure in any material respect from accepted trade standards for good and
workmanlike construction constitutes a cause for disciplinary action, unless the departure was in
accordance with plans and specifications prepared by or under the direct supervision of an
architect.

"(b) A willful departure from or disregard of plans or specifications in any material respect,
which is prejudicial to another, without the consent of the owner or his or her duly authorized
representative and without the consent of the person entitled to have the particular construction
project or operation completed in accordance with such plans or specifications, constitutes a cause
for disciplinary action."

11. Section 7112 of the Code states that "[o]mission or misrepresentation of a material
fact by an applicant or a licensee in obtaining, or renewing a license, or in adding a classification
to an existing license constitutes a cause for disciplinary action."

12. Section 7113 of the Code states that "[f]ailure in a material respect on the part of a
licensee to complete any construction project or operation for the price stated in the contract for
such construction project or operation or in any modification of such contract constitutes a cause
for disciplinary action."

13. Section 7116 of the Code states that "[t]he doing of any wilful or fraudulent act by the licensee as a contractor in consequence of which another is substantially injured constitutes a cause for disciplinary action."

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14. Section 7125.4 of the Code states:

"(a) The filing of the exemption certificate prescribed by this article that is false, or the
employment of a person subject to coverage under the workers' compensation laws after the filing
of an exemption certificate without first filing a Certificate of Workers' Compensation Insurance
or Certification of Self-Insurance in accordance with the provisions of this article, or the
employment of a person subject to coverage under the workers' compensation laws without
maintaining coverage for that person, constitutes cause for disciplinary action.

"(b) Any qualifier for a license who, under Section 7068.1 is responsible for assuring that a licensee complies with the provisions of this chapter, is also guilty of a misdemeanor for committing or failing to prevent the commission of any of the acts that are cause for disciplinary action under this section"

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15. Section 7154 of the Code states:

"(a) A home improvement contractor licensed under this chapter shall notify the registrar in
writing, on a form prescribed by the registrar, about the employment of a registered home
improvement salesperson, pursuant to the terms of this article. This notification requirement shall
include, but not be limited to, the name and registration number of the home improvement
salesperson who is employed by the contractor. The form shall be submitted prior to the home
improvement salesperson beginning work for the contractor.

"(b) A home improvement contractor shall notify the registrar in writing, on a form
prescribed by the registrar, when a registered home improvement salesperson ceases to be
employed by the contractor. This notification requirement shall include, but not be limited to, the
name and registration number of the home improvement salesperson who had been employed by
the contractor. The form shall be submitted within 90 days after the home improvement
salesperson ceases to be employed by the contractor.

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"(c) A home improvement contractor who employs a registered home improvement 1 salesperson to sell home improvement contracts, but who fails to report to the registrar pursuant 2 to subdivision (a) or (b), is subject to disciplinary action by the registrar. 3 "(d) A home improvement contractor who employs a person to sell home improvement 4 contracts while that person is not registered by the registrar as a home improvement salesperson 5 as provided in this article, is subject to disciplinary action by the registrar." 6 7 Section 7161 of the Code states: 16. "It is a misdemeanor for any person to engage in any of the following acts, the commission 8 of which shall be cause for disciplinary action against any licensee or applicant: 9 10 (b) Making any substantial misrepresentation in the procurement of a contract for a home 11 improvement or other work of improvement or making any false promise of character likely to 12 influence, persuade or, 1 induce any person to enter into such a contract. 13 14 17. the licensing act to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and 1 enforcement of the case. 2

Government Code section 11519(d), provides, in pertinent part, that the Registrar 3 19. may require restitution of damages suffered as a condition of probation in the event probation is 4 ordered. - 5

## **B.O PROJECT**

On or about August 21, 2016, Respondent, through unregistered salesperson 20.7 William Gabriel, entered into a contract with B.Q. to construct a sunroom in the backyard of their 8 home in San Jose, California (hereinafter "B.Q. project"). The contract amount was \$98,500.00. 9 Respondent, through unregistered salesperson William Gabriel, asked for and received a payment 10 of \$73,875.00, on August 21, 2016, telling B.Q. that the money would go towards their building materials. Respondent, through unregistered salesperson William Gabriel, promised B.Q. that the sunroom would be substantially completed by December 23, 2016.

Respondent began partial demolition of the existing concrete patio and removal of 21. 14 the existing sunroom and building eaves on or about September 23, 2016. After seven months of 15 little progress, B.Q. learned that a building permit had not been pulled and thereafter fired 16 Respondent on or about April 18, 2017, at a time when the sunroom had not been completed. 17 B.Q. had paid Respondent \$3,300.00 to remove the existing concrete slab, however Respondent 18 failed to remove the existing concrete slab. 19

22. B.Q. had to hire a correcting contractor to complete the sunroom in or about May 202017. The correcting contractor obtained the required permits and obtained engineered drawings. 21 None of Respondent's work on the B.Q. project was salvageable and it all had to be demolished. 22B.Q. had to pay an additional \$81,450.00 to complete the sunroom project. 23

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## FIRST CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

## (Departure From Accepted Trade Standards)

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Respondent is subject to discipline pursuant to Code section 7109(a), in that on the 23, 26 B.Q. project, it willfully departed from accepted trade standards for good and workmanlike 27construction by failing to obtain required permits and inspections, and failing to have engineered 28

1	plans prepared. In addition, all of the work Respondent performed on the B.Q. project was not to		
2	trade standards and was not compliant with building codes and had to be demolished prior to		
3	completing the project.

16	December 23, 2016. In truth and in fact, the project was not completed as of April 2017 when		
17	B.Q. terminated Respondent from the project.		
18	OTHER MATTERS		
19	31. Pursuant to sections 7097 and 7098 of the Code, if license number 1009268, B issued		
20	to Respondent is suspended or revoked, the Registrar may suspend or revoke, without notice, any		
21	other license issued in the name of Constance Ruth Gabriel or for which Constance Ruth Gabriel		
22	furnished the qualifying experience and appearance.		
23	32. Pursuant to section 7121 of the Code, if discipline is imposed on license number		
24	1009268, B issued to Respondent, Constance Ruth Gabriel shall be prohibited from serving as an		
25	officer, director, associate, partner, manager, or qualifying individual, or member of the personnel		
26	of record of any licensee during the time the discipline is imposed, and any licensee which		
27	employs, elects, or associates Constance Ruth Gabriel shall be subject to disciplinary action.		
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33. Pursuant to Section 7121.5 of the Code, if discipline is imposed on license number
 1009268, B issued to Respondent, Constance Ruth Gabriel shall be prohibited from serving as an
 officer, director, associate, partner, manager, or qualifying individual of any licensee during the
 time the discipline is imposed, whether or not he had knowledge or participated in the acts or
 omissions constituting grounds for discipline, and any licensee which employs, elects, or
 associates Constance Ruth Gabriel shall be subject to disciplinary action.

7 34. Pursuant to section 7122.5 of the Code, the causes for discipline established as to
8 Respondent constitute cause for discipline against individual license number 1004259, issued to
9 Gabriel Construction Company, Constance Ruth Gabriel, sole owner, regardless of whether she
10 had knowledge of or participated in the acts or omissions which constitute cause for discipline
11 against respondent.

35. Section 7095 of the Code provides, in pertinent part, that the Registrar in making hisorder may:

(a) Provide for the immediate complete suspension by the licensee of all operations as acontractor during the period fixed by the decision.

(b) Permit the licensee to complete any or all contracts shown by competent evidence taken
at the hearing to be then uncompleted.

(c) Impose upon the licensee compliance with such specific conditions as may be just in
connection with its operations as a contractor disclosed at the hearing, and may further provide
that until such conditions are complied with, no application for restoration of the suspended or
