New Board Member Appointed

Governor George Deukmejian announced the appointment of John H. Moore of Danville as a member of the Contractors State License Board. Moore replaces Anthony DiAngelo of Newark whose term expired. Moore has been the president of Electro-Test, Inc. of San Ramon since 1971. From 1969-71, he was the president of John H. Moore Electrical Construction of San Francisco.

Moore received his associate degree in electrical technology from San Francisco City College in 1962 and his bachelor's degree in electrical engineering from the University of California, Berkeley in 1970.

He is the president of the National Electrical Testing Association and a member of the International Association of Electrical Inspectors.

His term will expire June 1, 1989. Members receive \$50 per meeting day and necessary expenses. The position does require Senate confirmation.

Asbestos Certification

If you are a contractor that is engaged in asbestos-related work which involves 100 square feet or more, you must pass a certification examination and become certified by the CSLB to perform this work.

An asbestos certification examination will be administered for the first time on April 15, 1986.


Contractors removing asbestos must also contact CAL-OSHA and follow certain safety procedures.

BOARD COMMENDS PLUMBING CONTRACTOR/PHCC MEMBER

The 13 member CSLB board honored contractor Roger Lighthart at its quarterly meeting in Irvine for his assistance in investigating a major plumbing fraud case.

In addition to his C-36 plumbing license, Mr. Lighthart has a General Building (B) contractor's license and several other classifications. He is an active member of the Plumbing, Heating and Cooling Contractors of the Greater Los Angeles Area.

The board commended him for "conscientiously serving in the best interest of the public through his cooperation and willingness to examine and evaluate plumbing work and for providing expert witness testimony which helped to substantiate and bring a well-documented case against an irresponsible plumbing firm to a proper and speedy conclusion." The resolution also stated that "through his dedication, commitment and assistance, Mr. Lighthart helped to reestablish public confidence and trust in the plumbing contractors of this state whose image suffered a harsh blow due to the unlawful activities of one contractor; therefore, be it hereby resolved that Roger



Lighthart be congratulated and commended, and that his illustrious record of personal and professional achievement as a licensed contractor in the State of California be fully recognized; we extend our appreciation and best wishes for every success in the future."

GENERAL CONTRACTORS EXAM GIVEN ON COMPUTER TERMINAL

The CSLB launched its first pilot computer testing program in February 1986. Simply, the Business and Law and Class B (General Contractors) are taken at a computer terminal. Unlike a paper-and-pencil exam, the applicant reads the questions from the terminal screen and chooses the correct answer by touching the proper area on the screen.

The computer administered exams have the same number of questions, difficulty and structure as the paper-and-pencil exams. Best of all, at the end of the exam, the applicant's test is automatically scored and test results are

given immediately. The results are displayed on the applicant's terminal and will indicate whether the applicant passed the exam, the overall percentage score and the percent of questions answered correctly in each section of the exam.

Taking the exam on this system does not require any training in computer programming nor any experience in operating computer terminals. Applicants are randomly selected from a group of recent applicants for the "B" trade classification, but are not obligated to test on the computer program. Sites to take the exam are located in Irvine, Los Angeles and San Francisco.

Unlicensed Contractors = illusory low bids

In the past couple of months, the Contractors Board has had a couple of opportunities to testify before Legislative committees about the devastation wrought by the underground construction industry on the public and on licensed contractors. Both the Senate Committee on Business and Professions and the Assembly Committee on Labor and Employment held interim hearings, in November and December, 1985 respectively, on different aspects of the underground economy.


In November, Board Member Jack Fenton and Registrar Jack Maloney told members of the Senate committee about the ill effects caused by unlicensed advertising. I'd like to share with you some of the things that this Board has told the Legislature, trying to stimulate some support for legislative proposals to rectify the situation.

The Senate committee was primarily interested in finding out whether Yellow Page advertising really benefits the person who purchases the ads. Our testimony to the committee took a slightly different approach, by asking—Can the public use the Yellow Pages as a reliable source for construction goods and services?

Although Senator Montoya started the hearing by saying that he wasn't convinced that the furor over unlicensed contracting was warranted, we took this opportunity to inform the Legislature about some of the enforcement problems we encounter when dealing with unlicensed contractors, and how unlicensed advertising exacerbates those problems. Our experience has been that the public should not rely exclusively on advertising for the selection of a contractor, because so many unlicensed persons advertise illegally (without stating that they are unlicensed) and directories, such as the Yellow Pages, do not inform users that licenses are required for construction services.

Not that advertising is the only way that unlicensed contractors solicit work, but it does allow them to get their feet in the door, so to speak. And once they do, they have an advantage that licensed contractors usually cannot offer. Unlicensed contractors consistently submit the lowest bids on projects. The reasons that allow this are obvious: noncompliance with state and federal tax requirements, and their failure to contribute to employee benefit programs, such as disability and unemployment programs.

However, in general, the homeowner is more interested in getting his or her project

know, the public is not alone in becoming the victim of unlicensed contractors.

The state's economy suffers, too, as the Little Hoover Commission documented in its recent study of the underground economy. Participants in the underground economy receive or pay cash for work without withholding proper income, payroll, or sales taxes, and without filing the appropriate reports to the various taxing agencies. Experts estimate that California is losing more than \$2 billion in income taxes alone each year. But the effect doesn't stop there.

The participants in the underground economy also fraudulently file for welfare and rely on Medi-Cal programs for health care. As a result, the cost to the state to operate those programs is increased by millions of dollars annually. So, although these people feel no compunction to contribute to unemployment insurance or disability or Social Security, they don't hesitate to claim against those funds. So not only does the unlicensed contractor rob you, the licensed contractor, of business by offering bids which are artificially low, but you end up *subsidizing* unlicensed contractors by paying taxes to support the government programs mentioned above.

We are educating the public through our OPERATION OUTREACH seminars, informing them of their rights and

"New Exams Developed"

Over the last three years, the law and business examination and 35 of the 40 trade examinations (exams for all classes except C-11, 45, 55, 57 and 61) were newly written or revised. (See Table 1). Newer versions of the exams insure that the content is current and test for important information that contractors must know.

Consulting firms have surveyed licensed contractors in the field to identify all the work that a contractor must know to insure that consumers receive competent contracting services. Tests are developed based on the information supplied for this survey. The tests have been pretested, and the CSLB will continue to revise test questions and make periodic modifications, where necessary.

Study guides are available for the exams, which list topics covered in the test, recommended reading material and sample questions. A combined study guide for all exams should be available soon. This single

document will be distributed with applications, giving applicants more time to obtain and study suggested reference materials before the exam. laws regulating the construction industry. The Interdepartmental Contractor Enforcement, or I.C.E., program, which allows exchanges of information among the CSLB, the Department of Industrial Relations, the Employment Development Department, the Franchise Tax Board and the Internal Revenue Service regarding identification of unlicensed contractors, assumes that a contractor who violates one law (like licensure) is likely to violate other laws. So, when one regulatory agency discovers such a violation, the other agencies should be included to bring action against the violator, with cumulative penalties.

We also work with local building officials, providing license records so that permits can be issued to licensed contractors. Right now we are providing daily license tapes to the Sacramento County building department. When a contractor applies for a permit from them, the license number is brought up by the county on their computer and checked for current status. Sacramento County is refusing 130 permits a month because of license data available to them via these tapes. The board has a similar arrangement with the Los Angeles building department.

Other, smaller building departments are receiving microfiche readers and monthly microfiche of license information. We have also dedicated a telephone line to exclusive use by jurisdictions which issue fewer than 100 permits per month so that they, too, can verify license status prior to issuing a building permit.

I think you will agree that even with staff resources of fewer than 90 investigative deputies in the state, and a complaint workload of 25,000 complaints annually, and over the past few years accumulating a backlog of 10,500 complaints, the Board has developed some successful alternatives to fulfill its enforcement responsibilities.

A few years ago, the Board had a program specifically aimed at cracking down on unlicensed contractor advertising. Advertisements in local newspapers and telephone directories were checked and the issuance of building permits monitored to determine if contractors involved were properly licensed. Warning letters were sent for first or minor violations with no financial or other injury. Cases of repeated violations or injury to the public were pursued with the assistance of local prosecutors.

In the year and a half the program operated, we were able to see a noticeable improvement in contractor advertising in several geographic areas. Generally, small town publishers were cooperative, making attempts to monitor advertising. Publishers in larger areas, with larger volumes of ads and sales staff, were less cooperative. Although the Board judged the program a success, our budget committees directed the board to discontinue pro-active programs and to redirect staff to handling consumer complaints.

Last year, the Board proposed to introduce legislation to require publications accepting

advertising from contractors to require license numbers in those advertisements. In initial discussions with publishing associations, we discovered that we did not have their support. But this board, its members and chair, believe that the time to seriously consider such a proposal is now. The scope of the underground economy and the extent to which licensed advertising contributes to it are coming into focus. Unlicensed advertising is but the tip of the underground economy iceberg. Curbing that abuse is essential to curtailing underground construction activities. That is the message we took to the Legislature on behalf of our licensed constituency, and in the interest of protecting the public and preserving a private sector economy from unfair business practices. It is time for those who take the profit from advertising to accept at least part of the responsibility of advertising responsibly.

As a result of our message, GTE subsequently instructed its sales staff not to accept any advertisements unless the contractor provides a contractors license number or inserts a disclosure in the ad that he or she is not licensed. Staff have also been instructed to check the pocket license or wall certificate, prior to negotiating a sales contract. If GTE can so willingly enact such a policy, I am hopeful that others will follow their lead.

More Fake Sprinklers Found—Same Contractor Accused

A major contractor who glued sprinkler heads without a water supply to a school chapel ceiling in Monterey also installed a phantom fire system in an office building, officials said yesterday.

Revelations about contractor Dennis Frye have some state and local officials scrambling to find out whether he had done similar work to other Northern California buildings.

"We're not talking about poor workmanship here," said Sondra Vaughn, regional deputy for the State Contractors License Board. "We're talking about blatant theft."

Vaughn said that Frye, who faces an administrative hearing in Monterey on Tuesday and revocation of his license, worked on dozens of buildings—in Monterey County, the Bay Area and Sacramento. Some of them, including a system in Community Hospital of the Monterey Peninsula, have been inspected and are working properly.

She also revealed that the board and several local fire agencies are considering filing criminal charges against Frye, who officials said may have installed as much as 70 percent of the systems in the Monterey area before selling his business there in 1984.

Captain Charles Farrell of the San Francisco Fire Department's fire prevention unit said he knew of no buildings in the city that Frye worked on.

"It would be very difficult for that sort of thing to happen here," Farrell said. "We have systems inspected by the building inspector, the plumbing inspector and my people. With all the highrises, we are pretty thorough when it comes to those systems."

Frye is accused of installing a new sprinkler system in the chapel of the private York School near Monterey in 1983 that consisted of sprinkler heads glued to the ceiling with no connection to any water source.

Monterey Fire Chief Anthony Finks said

yesterday that the phony system was discovered on a tip from an informant. Finks said the system had passed inspection because the sprinkler heads appeared to be hooked up and could not be checked further without knocking holes in the ceiling.

Yesterday, officials revealed that a second phantom system had been discovered in the town of Marina near Monterey. Sprinklers installed by Frye in a building housing a termite inspection firm and a veterans service center were not hooked up to any water supply, a Marina Fire Department official said.

Frye's last known address was in Fair Oaks, near Sacramento. He could not be reached for comment yesterday, but Vaughn said he is expected to appear at the hearing on Tuesday.

Frye also owes the city of Monterey more than \$450,000 after losing a lawsuit alleging that he used a cheaper grade of pipe than the city's contract required when he installed pipe in water mains that serve fire hydrants.

Meanwhile, Monterey fire officials are investigating an October 1984 fire that caused \$200,000 damage to the Cannery Row building that housed Frye's business. He had sold the business to three of his employees about three months before the fire.

Sprinkler installer loses state license

SACRAMENTO—The Contractors State Licensing Board yesterday announced it has revoked the licenses of a contractor linked to faulty fire-protection sprinkler heads in at least three Monterey Peninsula locations.

Leticia Rico, spokeswoman for the board, said the board revoked the contractors license and the special sprinkler installation license held by Daniel Frye, 40, of Fair Oaks.

Rico said the revocation was based solely on board findings that Frye failed to connect water lines to sprinklers on the ceiling of the chapel of the York School, a private facility in Monterey.

Rico said the board found that Frye misrepresented that he properly installed the sprinklers in the school chapel. The sprinklers were glued to the ceiling, the board said.

At a board hearing last month in Monterey, board attorneys charged that Frye also was responsible for problems with sprinkler systems in a hospital and shopping center in the Monterey area.

Rico said the York school incident provided "sufficient evidence" to base the revocation action.

Roofer Nailed On Six Counts Including Theft

SACRAMENTO—Unlicensed contractor Raymond Cruz of Oakland, was arrested recently on six felony counts with bail set at \$10,000, the Contractors State License Board reports.

The six felony charges consisted of three counts of violating Business & Professions Code 7026.10—willful and intentional use of another's contractor's license to defraud another and three counts of grand theft—taking money under false pretenses.

Cruz allegedly used a contractor's license not belonging to him to contract and advertise.

Doing business as Magnum Roofing, the board says, he contracted with at least three different consumers for kitchen remodeling and roofing repairs. "An elderly widow on a pension gave him \$2,000 but Cruz allegedly failed to do the work." Other complaints

involve allegations of poor workmanship and abandonment.

On the day of the arrest, Cruz was at the Oakland/Piedmont Superior Court on armed robbery charges, but when the judge learned that the Contractors Board wanted Cruz arrested on felony charges, he postponed the robbery hearing so that Cruz could be arrested.

Gene Bell, supervisor of the CSLB's Oakland office, determined that Cruz was using someone else's license without his knowledge—a felony in California.

Bell urged homeowners considering hiring a contractor to call the Contractors State License Board to verify that the contractor is licensed and added that "consumers wind up paying for nonlicensed activity often do poor work and typically don't carry liability or workers compensation insurance."

Police arrest 3 in building fraud case

The president and two other officials of Delta Homes Inc. were arrested on grand theft charges Wednesday in connection with what state investigators said may be one of the biggest building fraud cases in California history.

Those arrested were Joseph Palifroni, 46, of Corona Del Mar, president of Delta Homes in West Los Angeles; former secretary-treasurer and sales representative Ruth Ray Levy, 64, of Los Angeles; and company architect Antonio Abellos Escario, 47, of Irvine.

The arrests were made after a warrant was issued Tuesday by Los Angeles Municipal Court Judge Larry P. Fidler. Each is charged with one count of grand theft in connection with failure to complete contracts to build homes or room additions.

Palifroni declined comment about his arrest on the advice of his attorney. Levy and Escario surrendered to authorities in Culver City and could not be reached for comment.

Larry McNeely, special investigator of the Contractors State License Board, said a search of the Delta office at 10913 Venice Blvd. turned up the names of 300 people who may have lost more than \$3 million. The board has been investigating Delta for 18 months.

"This is the most flagrant and callous operation that we've experienced in California," McNeely said. "The victimization extends to mostly low- and moderate-income families who have now lost their life savings."

McNeely said that after nearly two years in business, Delta Homes has accepted more than 300 contracts, but only about six homes ever were built beyond the foundation. License board investigator Ed Campos estimated about 100 of the projects were in the San Fernando Valley.

Delta Homes attracts customers through newspaper advertising that promises the firm builds homes at low prices, McNeely said. He said the advertisements have appeared in most major Southern California newspapers, including the Daily News, as well as Chinese and Spanish language papers in Los Angeles.

Investigators said Delta officials promised completion of homes in 120 days, asking for up-front payments of about \$8,000. Plans would be drawn, but work was delayed for many reasons and construction, in most cases, never began, McNeely said.

Palifroni, Levy and Escario were not present during the raid.

When company president Palifroni arrived at the one-story West Los Angeles headquarters in his black Mercedes, he turned himself over to police, saying, "We need to lock the place up to prevent vandalism."

The three suspects were booked at Culver City jail and released Wednesday afternoon on \$5,000 bail each. They were ordered to appear in Culver Municipal Court for arraignment on Jan. 22.

The raid and arrests followed at least 60 complaints made to the state license board and the Better Business Bureau of Los Angeles, authorities said.

One came from Mary Farnsworth, a 65-year-old retired beautician who hired Delta to build her home in Lake Los Angeles, east of Palmdale. Farnsworth lived in her home without lights, heat or gas for three months before a San Fernando Valley construction escrow company came to her aid and got another builder to do the needed work for free.

An official of the state license board said last month that the investigation intensified in October when Farnsworth's problems were reported to his agency.

Investigators said they believe that Delta has about 120 projects under way, although they said it would take about two weeks of checking through records seized Wednesday to get an exact figure.

The raid was conducted by the multi-agency Westside Major Crime Police Task Force, which includes the Los Angeles Police Department, the Los Angeles County District Attorney's office and the state license board.

Deputy District Attorney David Disco, who participated in the raid, said the California Attorney General's office also plans to seek a restraining order against Delta later this week in Los Angeles Superior Court. Disco is head of the district attorney's major-frauds division.

About a dozen employees were rounded up in Wednesday's early morning raid and questioned. None was arrested. Most had been employed no more than a month.

Five customers also came to the office during Wednesday's raid, all of whom complained about uncompleted work.

Leon Janes of Sylmar drove to the office after no one answered the phones Wednesday morning. He said he paid \$5,000 last month for work to begin at his lot in the Valley, but the proper permits were never issued.

"I failed to take the precautions I guess I normally would have taken," Janes said. "The deal sounded good, and I was in a hurry."

Shirley McKenzie said Levy, one of those arrested, had requested a \$7,000 payment. McKenzie added that she was afraid Delta would foreclose on her property in Beverly Glen.

"They drew up plans for less units than I wanted, and I didn't need the plans. So it's just as if they did nothing at all for six months," McKenzie said. "I don't know anything about contracting work, so I just trusted them completely."

Jesus Rivero of Los Angeles said he was shocked when an investigator told him he may never retrieve the money he paid Delta to build a house in the Silverlake area.

"I don't know what I'll do, I've saved three years for this money," said Rivero, an RTD worker with a wife and two children who agreed on Dec. 14, 1984, to pay \$55,000 for a 1,400-square-foot house. He said he had paid \$8,000 but no construction work has been started.

Precautions

Investigators and business leaders said Wednesday that people who want building done and are looking for contractors can take some precautions against fraud.

They suggested:

- Ask for a list of customers whose work has been completed in the past 90 days.
- Get estimates from a variety of contractors and subcontractors, if they are to be used.
- Contact the Contractors State License Board or the Better Business Bureau if there are questions about the company's past performance.

Investigators who talked to the customers Wednesday could offer little consolation. McNeely said it appeared that most of the company's assets had been spent.

A former salesman for Delta Homes came to the office during the raid to visit co-workers. He found that most of the people with whom he had worked five months before had either quit or had been fired.

"I left here because I was suspicious of things that were gong on," said Lyle Orth, a former salesman who said he sold \$1.5 million in contracts while at Delta Homes from February to August of 1985.

"None of my contracts were ever completed, and I never received my 2 percent commissions," Orth said. "In fact, I don't know anyone who worked there who ever got more than his \$200-a-week salary."

Orth said he has started his own business in San Bernardino.

During the raid, the employees were cooperative.

CLARIFYING LIEN RELEASES

The construction industry had been utilizing two different kinds of lien releases, an unconditional and conditional lien release. An unconditional lien release was used to release a claimant's right to a lien regardless of whether that person had been paid. A conditional lien release was given to release a claim of lien *only* after satisfactory payment was made. A conditional lien release was usually given by a subcontractor to a general contractor so that the general contractor could give it to the owner. The owner then would have some idea that the lien would be released upon the owner's payment.

This was the way business was done prior to a historical case decided in 1982. A plumbing subcontractor issued an unconditional lien release to a general contractor indicating that the plumbing contractor was paid. The plumbing sub actually was paid something less than the amount shown. The subcontractor then filed a mechanic's lien complaint against the property. The property owner argued that he could rely upon the unconditional lien release and that the property should be relieved from the lien of the plumbing subcontractor. The California Court of Appeals held that requiring the subcontractor to waive his lien rights was invalid. Therefore, the lien release given by the subcontractor had no force even if the subcontractor stated that he had been paid. It should be noted that this case involved commercial construction.

S.F. Contractor Gets 7 Years in Scam

A San Francisco contractor who bilked an elderly woman of \$65,000 in a home repair scam was sentenced yesterday to seven years in state prison.

John Kowalski, 42, was sentenced by San Francisco Superior Court Judge Laurence Kay. Kowalski was convicted last month of cheating the 76-year-old woman.

In April, the judge sentenced Kowalski's partner, William Oster, 59, to three years in prison for his role in the scam.

Since that case, many contractors and owners became very skeptical about the use of lien releases and joint checks were being issued on many construction projects. Due to the problems associated with joint checks and the uncertain state of affairs with respect to lien releases, the Associated General Contractors sought legislation to lend some stability to the use of lien releases.

Effective January 1, 1985, the new law (Civil Code Section 3262) states that if the subcontractor signs an unconditional lien release in "substantially the same form" as the lien release included in the law, then the owner, bonding company, etc., could rely on that lien release. However, in order for anyone to rely on that lien release, the lien release has to be in a form substantially similar to the one in the law.

The law includes four different forms: 1) an unconditional lien release for progress payments (unconditionally releasing the

claimant's claim for payments to date); 2) a conditional lien release for progress payments (releasing the claimant's claim for payments to date only upon receipt of those payments); 3) an unconditional lien release upon final payment (releasing claims unconditionally to the project); and 4) a conditional lien release upon final payment (releasing claims to the entire project upon payment). See examples of lien releases below.

It should be noted that nothing in the law requires a subcontractor or a material supplier to actually execute the particular documents listed in the law. However, if the general contractor wants an enforceable unconditional release, the documents will have to be executed in substantially the same form as the statutory language. If you have any questions regarding this jungle of the lien release, contact an attorney or your trade association that may provide information for your specific needs.

REACTIVATION FEES

At the January meeting, the board voted to change its policy regarding reactivation fees.

Section 7076.5 of the Contractors License Law states: "An inactive license may be reactivated by submitting an application acceptable to the Registrar by paying the full renewal fee for an active license and by fulfilling all other requirements of this chapter."

In the past, if a contractor reactivated his/her license and paid "the full renewal fee" for an active license (currently \$200) on August 15, 1985, and the license expiration

date was September 30, 1985; the contractor would still be expected to renew the license and pay the renewal fee (again) by September 30. The board received a number of complaints from licensees who reactivated shortly before their expiration dates. When they received their renewal notice they ignored it thinking they had taken care of their license status when they reactivated and paid \$200. If they did not ignore the renewal notice, they were understandably upset at having to pay another \$200.

The board's decision will effect the

following change. If your expiration date is September 30, 1986, and you reactivate on August 15, 1986; your expiration will automatically change from September 30, 1986, to two years from the end of the month in which you reactivated; that is, August 30, 1988.

It will be very important for all contractors to take note of the expiration date on their pocket license, since the expiration date with which contractors are accustomed, will change upon their reactivation.
