Contractors State License Board Reminds C-16 Fire Protection Contractors About Required Certification/Registration

The Contractors State License Board (CSLB) has an important reminder for C-16 Fire Protection contractors.

C-16 licensees and their employees (including fire sprinkler pipefitters, apprentices, and trainees) who install or repair water-based fire protection systems for **commercial or multi-family dwellings** must obtain a <u>Fire Sprinkler Fitter Certification</u> or <u>Fire Sprinkler Fitter Registration (Apprentice or Trainee)</u>. Licensees or their employees who fail to get this certification or registration before performing fire protection installations or repairs may face CSLB disciplinary action. Please note this does not apply to C-16 contractors and employees who work on one and two-family homes.
